Mr. MCCAIN (for himself, Mr. COVERDELL, Mr. CLELAND, and Mr. KERREY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Disabled Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation to establish a memorial in the District of Columbia or its environs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Disabled Veterans' LIFE
5 Memorial Foundation is authorized to establish a memo-
6 rial on Federal land in the District of Columbia or its envi-
7 rons to honor disabled American veterans who have served
8 in the Armed Forces of the United States.

1 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
2 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial au-
3 thorized by subsection (a) shall be in accordance with the
4 Act entitled “An Act to provide standards for placement
5 of commemorative works on certain Federal lands in the
6 District of Columbia and its environs, and for other pur-
7 poses”, approved November 14, 1986 (40 U.S.C. 1001 et
8 seq.).

9 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.**

10 The Disabled Veterans’ LIFE Memorial Foundation
11 shall be solely responsible for acceptance of contributions
12 for, and payment of the expenses of, the establishment of
13 the memorial authorized by section 1(a). No Federal funds
14 may be used to pay any expense of the establishment of
15 the memorial.

16 **SEC. 3. DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.**

17 If, upon payment of all expenses of the establishment
18 of the memorial authorized by section 1(a) (including the
19 maintenance and preservation amount provided for in sec-
20 tion 8(b) of the Act referred to in section 1(b)), or upon
21 expiration of the authority for the memorial under section
22 10(b) of such Act, there remains a balance of funds re-
23 ceived for the establishment of the memorial, the Disabled
24 Veterans’ LIFE Memorial Foundation shall transmit the
25 amount of the balance to the Secretary of the Treasury

1 for deposit in the account provided for in section 8(b)(1)
2 of such Act.
